What is a Lottery Application:

Applications are <u>not</u> first come, first served. Applicants will be selected based on a lottery system, apply any time during the opening week, as the date and time do not matter. Lottery applications do not guarantee placement on the waitlist or receipt of a Housing Choice Voucher. Applicants selected to be on the waitlist will be notified of their waitlist placement within three to four weeks and will only be contacted for eligibility screening appointments as assistance becomes available. The number of vouchers available in any given year is contingent on a variety of factors, including federal budget allocations.
